

### DEMI DRESSAGE - "CHRISTMAS STOCKINGS"



These tests are all about the short diagonals (if you squint at the movements when drawn out, the shapes made look like Christmas stockings!)

# The "Green Christmas Stocking" Test (GREEN test – walk only. May be ridden on or off Lead Rein)

- 1. Enter at A in walk, and proceed down the centre line. At C track left. C-H walk.
- 2. At H change the rein across the short diagonal to B. B-F-A walk.
- 3. At A turn down the centre line. A-X walk.
- 4. At X, halt, and take the reins in one hand to wave and shout out "Merry Christmas!" to the judge! \*
- 5. Re-take reins, proceed in walk and at C track right. C-M walk.
- 6. At M change the rein across the short diagonal to E. E-K-A walk.
- 7. At A turn down centre line and proceed in walk.
- 8. At X, halt and salute. Pat your pony and walk off on a long rein!

## The "Yellow Christmas Stocking" Test (YELLOW test - walk and simple trot. May be ridden on or off Lead Rein, or Assisted)

- 1. Enter at A in walk, and proceed down the centre line. At C track left.
- 2. Between C and H transition to trot. H-E-K trot.
- 3. Between K and A walk. A-F walk.
- 4. At F change the rein across the short diagonal to E. E-H-C walk.
- 5. At C transition to Halt, remain in halt and shout "Merry Christmas!" to the judge (don't deafen them!)
- 6. Proceed in walk. C-M walk.
- 7. At M, take both reins in the outside (left) hand and walk down the long side of the arena with the inside (right) arm held out to the inside. At F retake the reins in both hands. F-A walk.
- 8. Between A and K transition to trot. K-E-H trot
- 9. Between H and C walk. C-M walk.
- 10. At M, change the rein across the short diagonal to E. E-K-A walk.
- 11. At A turn down the centre line and proceed in walk.
- 12. At X, halt and salute. Pat your pony and walk off on a long rein!

Pony's Willingness and Harmony with Rider

#### The "Yellow-Plus Christmas Stocking" Test (YELLOW-PLUS test - extended walk and trot)

- 1. Enter at A in trot, and proceed down the centre line. At C track left. C-H-E trot.
- 2. At E, change the rein across the short diagonal to F. F-A-K trot.
- 3. Between K and E ride a transition to walk for at least five pony lengths.
- 4. Between E and H transition to trot. H-C-M trot.
- 5. At M, take both reins in the outside (left) hand and trot down the long side of the arena with the inside (right) arm held out to the inside. At F retake the reins in both hands. F-A-K-E trot.
- 6. At E, change the rein across the short diagonal to M. M-C-H trot.
- 7. Between H and E ride a transition to walk for at least five pony lengths.
- 8. Between E and K transition to trot. K-A-F trot.
- 9. At F, take both reins in the outside (right) hand and trot down the long side of the arena with the inside (left) arm held out to the inside. At M retake the reins in both hands. M-C-H-E-K trot.
- 10. Between K and A transition to walk. A-F walk.
- 11. At F, change the rein to E, allowing your pony to take a longer rein. At E re-take your reins. E-H walk.
- 12. Between H and C, transition to trot. C-M-B-F-A trot.
- 13. At A turn down the centre line and proceed in trot.
- 14. At X, halt (can be progressive) and salute. Pat your pony and walk off on a long rein!

#### The "Blue Christmas Stocking" Test (BLUE test - walk, trot and simple canter)

- Enter at A in trot, and proceed down the centre line. At C track left. C-H-E trot. 1.
- 2. At E change the rein across the short diagonal to F. F-A-K trot.
- 3. At K, take both reins in the outside (left) hand and trot down the long side of the arena with the inside (right) arm held out to the inside. At H retake the reins in both hands. H-C-M-B trot.
- 4. At B change the rein across the short diagonal to K. K-A-F trot.
- 5. At F, take both reins in the outside (right) hand and trot down the long side of the arena with the inside (left) arm held out to the inside. At M retake the reins in both hands. M-C trot.
- 6. Between C and H transition to canter (left). H-E-K canter.
- 7. Between K and A transition to trot. AF trot.
- 8. At F change the rein across the short diagonal to E. E-H-C trot.
- 9. Between C and M transition to canter (right). M-B-F canter.
- 10. Between F and A transition to trot. A-K-E trot.
- 11. Between E and H, transition to walk. H-C-M medium walk.
- 12. At M change the rein to E, allowing your pony to take a longer rein. At E re-take your reins. E-K medium walk.
- 13. At K transition to trot. K-A trot.
- 14. At A turn down the centre line and proceed in trot.
- 6 15. At X, halt (can be progressive) and salute. Pat your pony and walk off on a long rein!

#### The "Red Christmas Stocking" Test (RED test - walk, trot and canter)

- Enter at A in trot, and proceed down the centre line. At C track left. C-H-E trot. 1.
- At E change the rein across the short diagonal to F. F-A-K-E-H trot. 2.
- 3. Between H and C transition to canter (right). C-M-B-F-A-K-E canter.
- 4. Between E and H transition to trot. H-C-M trot.
- At M, take both reins in the outside (left) hand and trot down the long side of the arena with the inside 5. (right) arm held out to the inside. At F retake the reins in both hands. F-A-K-E trot.
- 6. At E change the rein across the short diagonal to M. M-C-H-E-K trot.
- 7. Between K and A transition to canter (left). A-F-B-M-C-H-E canter.
- 8. Between E and K transition to trot. K-A-F trot.
- 9. At F, change the rein across the short diagonal to E. E-H-C trot.
- 10. At C transition to medium walk.
- 11. At M change the rein to E, allowing your pony to take a longer rein. At E re-take your reins. E-K medium walk.
- 12. At K, transition to trot. K-A trot.
- 13. At A turn down centre line and proceed in trot.
- 14. At X, halt (can be progressive) and salute. Pat your pony and walk off on a long rein!
